## TRANSITION TEAM UPDATE

The Transition Team held its final meeting on May 30, 2018. The Council had requested additional details regarding how the Steering Committee would function and how members of the Steering Committee would be selected. The Transition Team recommended the following structure and process:

- The current Administrative Committee remain in place until the fall of 2018 or until the Steering Committee is staffed and ready to assume responsibilities.
- The at-large members representing Worship, Finance/Facilities, Community, and Membership, would normally serve a three year term although the initial terms for these members would be staggered so that two members would initially serve for one year, one member would serve a two year term, and one member would serve a three year term. This would allow for greater continuity year to year for the committee as new members are appointed in the future.
- Recommendations to Council for the initial Steering Committee members will come from the Transition Team and Administrative Committee. The congregation will be asked to submit names to the Transition Team or Administration Committee for consideration for the initial Steering Committee. All subsequent members will come as a recommendation to Council by the Officers of Council.
- The Steering Committee will elect its own Chairperson annually.

The team agreed that it may be helpful to consult with Rev. Duane Kelderman again in order to gain some insight as to how our congregation might best implement the proposed changes. Steve Zuiderveen will try to arrange a meeting with Rev. Kelderman, the Chair of Elders, the Chair of Deacons, and himself.

The Pastor Search Committee has met several times over the last couple of months. There is a lot of prep work that needs to be done! So far we have almost finalized our “Church Profile”, which will then be uploaded to the Christian Reformed Church’s website. This is where pastors who are open to a call will learn that we are searching and they will be able to view the information about our South Grandville.

We have made the official request to Classis Grandville to assign a classical counselor. This is a pastor from one of the other Classis Grandville churches who will walk alongside the search team to make sure we’re following protocol for a pastor search in the CRC and will be able to advise us if we have questions.

One of the next big steps is that we’ll begin reviewing potential candidates, probably around mid-summer. If you know of someone you would like to be considered as our next pastor, please talk to any of the members of our team, or fill out a suggestion form available on the table by the office.
